Congratulations on your recent appointment by President Trump to serve as the next Director of the U.S. Secret Service (USSS). As you know well, this is both a great honor and a great responsibility. Your courageous actions on July 13, 2024, at the Butler, PA rally, while serving as President Trump's Special Agent in Charge (SAIC), demonstrate your superb commitment to your agency's zero-fail mission.

Our House Task Force on the Attempted Assassination of Donald J. Trump undertook a comprehensive analysis of what occurred in both Butler, PA and West Palm Beach, FL. After conducting transcribed interviews with law enforcement and security personnel who were present at both events, it's abundantly clear that recent USSS leadership bears chief responsibility for the unacceptable failures that nearly cost President Trump his life. Our findings and recommendations are included in the Task Force's Final Report. We highly encourage you to read this report thoroughly and strongly consider the recommendations included therein.

Finally, we cannot stress enough the need for a dramatic change in culture at USSS. The events of July 13 in particular underscore why the world's premier protective agency, USSS, can never succumb to complacency. There is good evidence that, as the agency's next director, you will effect such change, and we are reassured by President Trump's overt confidence in you as his choice to lead.
